About Working with Lead-Based Paint Homes or apartments built before 1978 may contain lead paint Anyone who is paid to perform work that disturbs lead-based paint in homes, child-care facilities and pre-schools built before 1978 This may include, but is not limited to, residential rental property

Child Care Lead Poisoning Prevention

Blood lead tests should be done at 12 and 24 months for children in publicly funded programs for low-income children (like Medi-Cal, CHDP, and WIC) All other children should be assessed for risk of lead exposure by their health care provider at every well child visit up to age 6
